Below are the different ways in which you may become involved in this year's seminar, and an explanation of the commitment required. Please also pay careful attention to the instructions that follow.

A. Program Committee

These alumni will work with our Vice Chair of program. Some duties will include greeting and directing speakers, hosting guest speakers, working with the student introducers, and assisting with thank you note writing.

B. Operations Committee

These alumni will help with set up and clean up of event rooms, opening and closing ceremonies, student registration, basket raffle, the dance, and talent show coordination. The people on this committee are really responsible for most of the logistics of the seminar. Some members of this committee will work on A/V and computer projects including PowerPoint, photos, running sound booths, and music editing.

C. Recycling Committee

These alumni will assist our recycling chairperson with the recycling and food-compost program. Some pre-seminar work may be required to assist with the aluminum tab drive and the overall enhancement of the program.

D. Floaters

These alumni will do a little bit of everything. These people will do miscellaneous tasks and help as our Vice Chairs need something. Of course these folks will also do lots of HOB Y cheers!

Criteria for Positions A – D:

1. Attendance of the ENTIRE seminar (May 16, 2012 at 7pm until May 20, 2012 at 4pm).
2. 100 Leadership for Service hours completed. By the time of the seminar you must have your goal complete. Preference will be given to those who have finished by application review in January.
3. You must have a student registered from your school to attend this year's seminar.

Please note that due to high volume of applications and space, it is likely that we will have to turn away 50% of those that apply to be members of Team Alumni.

IMPORTANT ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Fundraising: All alumni will be asked to assist in our fundraising efforts. HOB Y is a non-profit that runs on donations from corporations, businesses, and individual donors. This being the case, we require all team alumni to fundraise a minimum of \$275.00 to be submitted by April 15, 2012. How can you raise these funds? One idea is to ask 14 of your friends, family, teachers, coaches, etc. to donate \$20.00 each to help you attend the HOB Y seminar. You will also be provided with a list of ways you can help achieve your fundraising goal by helping with seminar needs (selling program ads, securing gift-in-kind items, etc.).



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Registration:

If you are interested in attending the entire seminar, please follow these steps.

1. Complete the Team Alumni application form.
2. Complete the Team alumni questionnaire.
3. Please make sure your name is on all pages of your documents.
4. Print all forms. Be sure to double-check your answers and sign!
5. Send all the above information so that they are received by January 9, 2012 (Information on where to send it is below).
6. You will be contacted by February 1, 2012. At that time we will let you know if you have been selected, and if so, in which area we will best be able to utilize your talents.
7. Please note that if you are selected to return as a volunteer, a non-refundable deposit of \$50 will be required by February 28, 2012.
8. The remaining portion of the \$275.00 fundraised amount will be due by April 28, 2012. However, we do not want cost to be a reason you do not attend. If you have any concerns about this please contact us.
